The following 2 nights will be at Rimba Eco Lodge where we can hear the plaintive cry of gibbons and see the resident macaques from our rooms.

Our days will start early to make best use of the morning light, a highlight being the Proboscis monkeys.

Jackie will hold photography workshops, for those interested throughout the tour, with limitless opportunities for practice.

Mara will provide information about the problems facing wild orang-utans, and the need to conserve their habitat.
